AV =	Avoiding serpent (fear overriding ease with proximity)/ unseen proximity
Ba =	Me or another being attacked/ chased/ come to-at me/ "stalked"/ harassed
Bsb =	Strike/ being bit or seeing/ knowing another bitten/ cannot be freed of bite/ being in its coils
Bf =	Being fascinated by: seeing/ watching/ anticipating/ imagining serpent/ serpent form/ birthing
C =	Chasing away by throwing-doing something/ willing its movement/controlling it/ gathering them

F =	Find a snake in my hand(s), at-near my head/ on me, about to be on me
GC =	Gender change: male to female/ female to male
GS =	Gnostic Spirit: gaining: spiritual wisdom/ serpent powers/ symbolic power/ healing
H =	Harmless
HO =	Holding head firmly so as not to be bit
HP =	Handling/ playing with/ milking venom for medicine
KAI =	Kill / Attack/ hitting/ thinking-intending to attack serpent/ capturing snake, or trying to
KP =	Known Person
LS =	Large Serpent: Length/Width
MYTH=	Mythological: God(s)/ Ancestral Spirit/ Conscious Mind/ Cosmos/ Heaven/ Stars/ Dragon Snake
N =	Nature: Desert/ Jungle/ Dry brush-grass-leaves area/ Roads/ Hills/ Outdoors/ not Trees (below)
OB =	Observing
OU =	Ouroboros
PAD =	Primal/Anticipatory Danger: seeing/ intensely looking for/ warning or alerting others/ concerned for
PB =	Partial Body: Head-tail-fangs/ Skin separate from body/ skinned/ looks like skin/ dead-crushed serpent
PFRA =	Protecting snake(s)/ freeing/ releasing/ allowing closeness/ compassion
PH =	Phallic: sexual organ representation/ Freudian interpretation
R =	Rattles from Rattlesnake seen/ already removed/ sound of

SR	=	Sorrow/Regret for harming/ killing serpent/ seeing one(s) harmed/ somehow crushed but alive
T	=	Tree: Mythological/ divine resurrection medium/ habitat
US	=	Use serpent to kill / attack other(s)/ scare another by sound of rattles
U	=	Underground/ cavern or hole in ground/ slippery deep pit walls/ cave/ cliff edge-bank/ burying itself
V	=	Venom vomited over head/ squeeze out/ serpent dissolves into liquid venom/ spread/ toxic
W	=	Water/ stream/ body of water/ rain/ watery environment/ Ocean
